

# How to Create a New Facebook Group

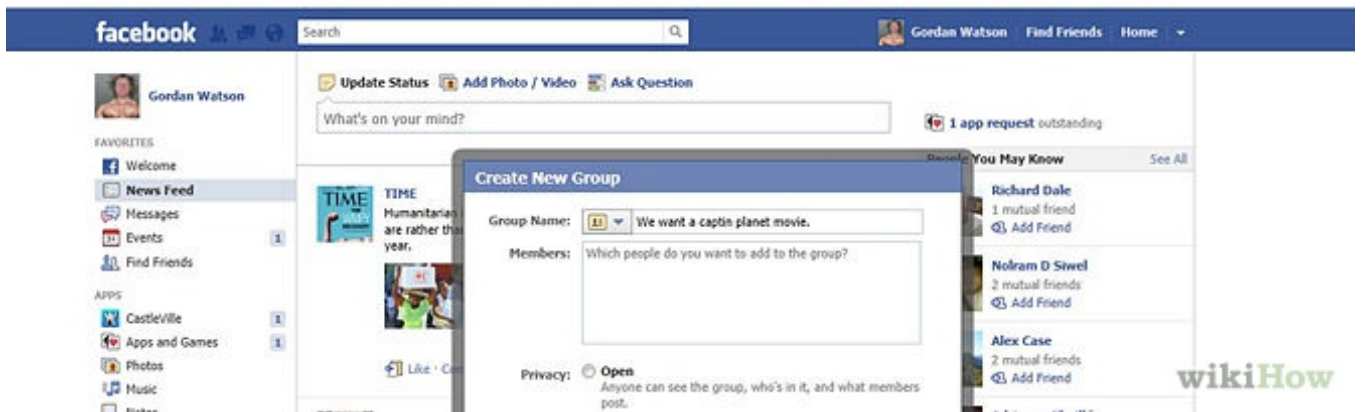
1. **Login to Facebook** or [create an account](#) if you don't have one yet.

2. Click "Create a group" at the top of that page.

3. **Give your group a name.** Make sure the name is distinct and simple, if it is too complicated, no one will ever find it and your membership in the group will be limited.

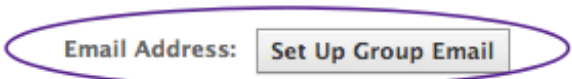

6. **Fill out the contact information.** You may decide to enter things like street address and telephone number in the description, or you can just set up a Facebook email for your group.


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7. **Choose your privacy settings.** By creating an open group, anybody on Facebook will be allowed to see posts and join the group. A closed group will allow only invited members to see posts or join, but anyone on Facebook will be able to search the group. A private group means that only those invited will see the group, including all its members and posts.

- You can also take this time to choose the membership approval and posting permission options.
